Six from our church have already attended the counselor training program for the upcoming "Good News Festival" with Franklin Graham at Chesapeake Arena, August 22-23. This special event will help to bring many new people to Christ across the Oklahoma City area. Many of us feel that personal, one-to-one, sharing of the Gospel is more effective than so-called "Mass Evangelism." Nevertheless, large gatherings like this have also been fruitful means of sharing the Gospel, ever since Jesus' preaching by the seaside and John Wesley's preaching in the public squares and open fields. This event will truly be a time a "personal evangelism," because most who respond will have been invited to the event by a Christian friend. Each person who responds is prayed with on-site, one-to-one, by a counselor, visited soon after at home, and encouraged to attend a small group sponsored by the local church. I am sure that YOU know someone who might be more likely to attend a big event like this than to come to church with you or sit down to study the Bible!

BUT—good results require having enough counselors and others trained to respond: many more are needed. Additional training classes are being offered in July. These classes are required for those desiring to serve as counselors, but they will be inspirational and informative for your own Christian life and witness before and long after the coming event. The classes are free and offered at enough different times and locations to assure that almost anyone can get involved. Does God want YOU to help counsel?
