May is a great month at Midwest City Free Methodist Church! On the first two Sundays, we continue celebrating Resurrection, with sermons from John 21 to help us live in the presence of the Risen Christ and carry on his work. **On May 7**, we will honor **Anita Baird** as she retires from public school teaching. Have you noticed that her zeal to serve children through our church seems to be growing as she has neared retirement? You will hear more from her soon about plans for a very special

sort of Vacation Bible School! We will also honor and *celebrate all the mothers on May 8. May 15* brings *Pentecost Sunday*, as we celebrate the giving of the Holy Spirit to help us fulfill the calling Jesus gave us.

May 22 is a doubly special day as we honor **Mario Lawson and Bryan Bediako**, whose **high school graduations** will be that week, and as we plan to celebrate the **baptism** of some young new believers. We are so pleased with the academic and spiritual progress of our youth. Just today one of our youth leaders remarked to me about how one of the teens was remembering and referring back to earlier lessons from the Bible. Please pray for all those who work with children and teens, that they may have wisdom, insight, courage, and everything else they need. That's a prayer God promises to answer!

I am glad this church is a *mission-minded congregation*. We support regularly a young family reaching out in creative ways to *an Asian country closed to formal "missionaries*." Each month we feature a different local, national, or international ministry touching lives for Christ, and direct special offerings there. Last month we shared with a Free Methodist church of about 100 people in *Jordan*, ministering regularly to *4000 refugee families fleeing the ISIS terror* in the Middle East, and over the past six years we have also supported and had live reports from a couple ministering in *Iraq*. Next month we will focus on *Umri Mission Hospital in India*, and learn through Eric Baird of opportunities to support evangelistic and health care ministries in that country. May mission offerings will help to fund scholarships for our *youth to this summer's Christian camping* activities.

We will finish this month with a special presentation on **May 29 by Dr. Glenn Lorenz**, currently head of the Religion Department at Central Christian College of Kansas, who, with his wife Wendy and family will be going soon to *Costa Rica to develop new ministerial training options* for the rapidly expanding Free Methodist churches of Central America. As we learn of what God is doing around the world, we are inspired to pray, give—and for some of us, also, to GO! Stay tuned . . .

Be sure to look over all the activities noted on the other side—there is something very good for every one of us!

PENTECOST

Pentecost is the Jewish spring harvest festival, referred to in the Old Testament as the Feast of Weeks, Festival of Reaping or Day of First Fruits. Because it is 50 days after Passover it was called **PENTE**cost in the Greek Language. It was celebrated also as the anniversary of the giving of the Law on Mt. Sinai under Moses. In the Christian Church, Pentecost celebrates the day, seven weeks after the Resurrection, when the early Christians first experienced the giving of the Holy Spirit. It is sometimes called the "Birthday of the Church." As we celebrate on May 15th, let us rejoice that through the Holy Spirit, God is with us every day.
